I ran memprofiler (I have tried it with different frameworks and they all report the same thing) and it says that the majority of the memory is being used in the UIKit. However, if I look at the memory allocation in the xcode console, it shows that only 4 blocks are being used, so the memory utilization is ~1.6MB. I've looked through the code and nothing really stands out. Any ideas? A: I had to adjust the profile's max frame rate from 60 to 1. The default rate causes frames to be dropped whenever the animation will be very time-consuming. Setting the maximum rate to 1 should resolve the issue.
